Purpose

To provide clarity of when Tipping Fees will not be charged for the clean up of Dangerous or Unsightly Premises.

Procedures

Tipping fees will not be charged to commercial haulers that are hired to clean up a property which has been determined, by the Municipality of East Hants, to be dangerous or unsightly; whether or not an order has been issued to clean-up the property.

Tipping fees will not be charged to property accounts for the clean-up of properties determined, by the Municipality of East Hants, to be dangerous or unsightly.

All commercial haulers hired to clean-up a property that has been determined to be dangerous or unsightly, must present documentation from the Municipality of East Hants to municipal staff at the East Hants Waste Management Centre indicating what property the waste has been collected from, and that the property has been determined to be dangerous or unsightly by the Municipality of East Hants.

All commercial haulers hired to clean-up dangerous or unsightly premises are required to follow proper waste separation procedures.
