REMINDERS FOR SUCCESSFUL CURBSIDE COLLECTION IN 2019!

Limits & Restrictions

The table to the **right** outlines the collection limits (quantity) and restrictions (weights & materials) for a residential household for every collection day. If you own an apartment building or business and would like more information on limits at those locations please call us at the Solid Waste Hotline.

Note: Garbage and recycling bags are not to exceed standard sizes (~25 inches x 33 inches).

Timing

Multiple trucks collect material from your property, and they do not necessarily travel together. For this reason, it is important to have all your materials curbside by 7:00 a.m.

Same Day Collection with Multiple Trucks

Curbside collection is based on week 1 = collection and week 2 = no collection. Therefore, your garbage, recyclables, green cart and other acceptable items must be placed curbside on the same day. Multiple trucks means that collection of some materials may be earlier in the day compared to other materials.

Reporting a Missed Collection

If you believe your material was missed, or you have another concern with collection, please let us know. You can report your concern to the Solid Waste Hotline (same day is best!) at 1-888-873-3332. If it is after 4:00 p.m. please leave a message with your name, number, civic address and concern.

GARBAGE: Limit 5 bags











- No RED, ORANGE or YELLOW bags will be collected
- Black or green bags ONLY
- Max weight 25kg/55lbs per bag
- No construction & renovation waste

FURNITURE:

- Limit 3 pieces (ex. sofa or chair
- Max weight 100kg/220lbs per item

ORGANICS:

- 1 municipal issued cart (max. 220lbs)
- 6 paper leaf bags
- 5 bundles of brush (2ft x 2ft x 4ft bundles; max 35lbs; no branch diameter larger than 2.5 inches)

RECYCLABLES: Limit 8 bags/bundles



- Clear or transparent blue bags only
- Max weight 25kg/55lbs per bag

ELECTRONICS:

- 1 larger item (ex. TV or computer)
- 1 small box of accessories (ex. cords, remotes, computer mice, keyboards)

METAL:

- 1 household appliance (ex. stove)
- 3 smaller items (bicycle, BBQ)
- X No construction materials are collected curbside—take to the Waste Management Centre
- X No household hazardous wastes are collected curbside—see inside the newsletter for more information

Collection day changes for 2019? NO!

Following a fire at the East Hants Waste Management Centre in June 2018, we are advising folks of common household products that require some additional consideration for proper disposal.

Batteries: For items so small they can be a BIG hazard. Batteries can be dropped off for recycling at the Waste Management Centre or visit call2recycle.ca for battery and cellphone drop-off locations near you.



Medical Needles or Sharps: Every pharmacy in Nova Scotia offers free sharps containers, and will take full ones back.



Pressurized Containers: These do not belong in the garbage or recycling. Please drop-off at one of our mobile community events or at the Waste Management Centre year-round.



Paints: Leftover paint and empty paint cans are accepted at ENVIRO-DEPOTS, designated retailers, and at the Waste Management Centre.



Household Chemicals: If you have no use for a particular cleaner, offer it to a family member or neighbour. If not, they are accepted at our mobile community events or at the Waste Management Centre.



Pharmaceuticals: Never flush old medications! Return unused or expired medications to your local pharmacy for proper disposal.

Maximum Weight 220lbs

All Food Waste

Including fruit and vegetable peelings, meat, fish, dairy products, cooking oil and fat (cooled, wipe with paper towel and place in cart), bones, coffee grounds & filters, tea bags,

Soiled Paper

Paper towels, tissues, paper plates, napkins, sugar & flour bags, freezer & waxed paper, pizza boxes.

Yard Waste/Other

Grass, leaves, twigs, plants, sawdust, wood shavings.

Not for the Cart

- x No Plastic bags (including those labeled 'biodegradable')
- x No Ashes x No Milk Containers
- x No Cans, Bottles, or Cups x No Rocks, Sod, or Dirt

Excess organic material can be placed next to your green cart in up to 6 paper bags or open top containers, like a cardboard box, year round.

Max. 8 bags/bundles per collection, transparent blue or clear bags only

Recycling Collection Notes:

- · Paper must be clean and dry. Metal fasteners and plastic bindings must be removed and placed in regular garbage.
- Containers must be clean and dry, NO CAPS, NO NEEDLES.
- Beverage containers (excluding milk products) can be returned to an ENVIRO-DEPOT™ for refund.

Metal Collection:

- A separate truck is used to collect metal items, therefore, collection may occur at a different time from your other recyclables. Please make sure your metal items are visible (not hidden by other bags).
- 1 large household appliance per collection (stove, fridge, etc.).
- Up to 3 other large metal items will be collected bi-weekly. Examples: microwaves, toasters, air conditioner, dehumidifier, bicycle, BBQ, cardboard box with pots, pans, utensils.
- CFCs do not need to be removed from fridges for collection (the Municipality will remove CFCs).
- Items that cannot fit into the collection truck will not be collected.















Reminders

- All loads must be covered/secure when transporting material to the WMC.
- All materials need to be properly sorted and separated.
- When arriving at the facility, all vehicles must stop and check-in at the Scale House.
- Due to the volume of traffic and the heavy equipment at the WMC, please follow the instructions from staff to ensure your safety.

Material We Manage

There are separate drop-off areas for the materials. Using the list below, you can have your items separated before you arrive.

- Tires (with or without rims)
- Metal (staff remove CFCs from appliances on-site)
- Paint
- Electronics
- Regular garbage
- Recyclables
- Clean wood
- Construction waste
- Household hazardous waste (residential only)

Notes from Staff

- Mirrors, window glass, dishes, pool liners, mattresses and couches are all regular garbage.
- Construction waste is not garbage, and must be separated before disposal at the WMC. Example: insulation is construction waste.

MEDICAL NEEDLES & SHARPS

Sharps in garbage bags can present a real health risk or cause serious harm to those providing us curbside collection services. Let's all do our part to help everyone go home safe at the end of the work day.

Every pharmacy in Nova Scotia offers free sharps containers, and will take full ones back.

Composting in East Hants

Each household is provided a large green cart for organics collection. Sometimes carts get damaged by regular usage, critters chewing at vents, or plows. To request your cart be fixed or replaced, please call the Solid Waste Hotline at 1-888-873-3332.

If you are building a new home, your cart will be delivered within 2-3 weeks of receiving your occupancy permit (we receive this directly from the Planning & Development Department). If you are moving, please leave your green cart on the property.

Backyard composting is a cost-effective and environmentally friendly way to manage most food scraps. But for those items that don't belong there — please use your green cart.
