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1. QUESTIONS

Has the Nova Scotia Department of Environment and Climate Change been consulted about this proposed C&D expansion, specifically related to the extension of the design height compared to the original design?

No; The scope would include design and the application for approval package & submission with Nova Scotia Department of Environment & Climate Change, which would need to support the proposed expansion. The design will need to be in accordance with the Solid Waste Management Facility Guidelines, dated July 5th, 2023.

Does the Municipality have any influent contamination data or effluent treatment data for the sediment pond?

Our Environmental Monitoring Program Annual Report, includes in and out water quality data collected quarterly for the sedimentation pond. The Municipality of East Hants will share data from our environmental monitoring program with the successful Consultant to support any required submissions with NSECC.

Could the Municipality provide recent environmental monitoring data (hydrogeological data) for the Site?

The Municipality of East Hants will share data from our environmental monitoring program with the successful Consultant to support any required submissions with NSECC.

Could the Municipality extend the proposal due date by three weeks (revised submission date April 16, 2025)?

No extension is granted at this time. East Hants may reconsider if there are external factors out of a supplier's control that East Hants is not aware of as of the publishing of this Addendum.
