Curbside Collection Services



Same Day Collection with Multiple Trucks

Curbside collection is based on week 1 = collection and week 2 = no collection. Therefore, your garbage, recyclables, green cart and other acceptable items must be placed curbside together.



Timing

Multiple trucks collect material from your property, and they do not necessarily travel together. Multiple trucks mean that collection of some materials may be earlier in the day compared to other materials. For this reason, it is important to have all your materials curbside by 7:00 a.m.



Reporting a Missed Collection

If you believe your material was missed, or you have another concern with collection, please let us know! You can report your concern to the Solid Waste Hotline, same day is best, at 1-888-873-3332. If it is after 4:00 p.m. please leave a message with your name, number, civic address and concern.



Green Carts

Each household is provided a large green cart for organics collection. Sometimes carts get damaged by regular usage, critters chewing at vents, or plows. To request your cart be fixed or replaced, please call the Solid Waste Hotline at 1-888-873-3332.

Collectable Materials & Restrictions



GARBAGE: 5 bags (26 x 32.5")

- No red, orange or yellow bags will be collected
- Black or green bags only (securely tied)
- Max weight 25kg/55lbs per bag
- No construction & renovation waste



RECYCLABLES: 8 bags/bundles (26 x 32.5")

- Clear or transparent blue bags only (securely tied)
- Max weight 25kg/55lbs per bag
- Separate bag groups: Bag #1: Paper Products, Bag #2: Containers



FURNITURE: 3 pieces (e.g. sofa, chair)

• Max weight 100kg/220lbs per item



ORGANICS: 1 municipal issued cart (max. 220lbs)

- + 6 paper leaf bags
- + 5 bundles of brush (2ft x 2ft x 4ft bundles; max 35lbs; no branch diameter larger than 2 cm)
- Plastic bags, even those labelled as compostable or biodegradable, are not accepted in your organics cart



ELECTRONICS: 1 larger item (ex. TV or computer)

• + 1 small box of accessories (ex. cords, keyboards)



METAL: 1 household appliance (ex. stove)

• + 3 smaller items (bicycle, BBQ)





Using the list below, please separate your items before you arrive.

• Tires (with or without rims)

- Paint
- Electronics
- Regular garbage
- Recyclables
- Metal (staff remove the CFCs from applicable appliances on-site)
- Clean wood
- Construction waste
- Household hazardous waste (residential only)

Reminders

- All material brought to the WMC must be properly sorted. All loads are subject to inspection.
- All vehicles must stop at the Scale House when entering and exiting the site.
- For the safety of all persons on the site, visitors are reminded to drive slowly and to make eye contact with Heavy Equipment Operators.
- Speed limit on site is 20 km/hr.
- Children under the age of 12 and pets must remain inside the vehicle at all times on site.
- Do not enter the transfer station when heavy equipment or large vehicles are inside unless directed to by staff.


