East Hants HR Update

- East Hants District total of 30 employees (26 Police officers, 4 Detachment Assistants)
- Current staff shortage No Change 6 due to Illness (2), Secondments (2), Paternity leave (1), Awaiting arrival from transfer in (1)
- Rawdon PSE received indeterminate letter of offer last week
- New Cadet (William McNutt) identified and is stated to arrive December 31st
- One DSA from the Enfield Detachment has left for a new opportunity. We are the process of hiring another
- Two new Public Servant positions in process
- New Corporal Supervisor (Jared Ryan) will start December 1st
- New Auxiliary member (Nathan Joyce) starting soon!

East Hants Operations Update

- Operations slowing for the fall as per normal
- COVID has not hindered operations this quarter
- Continuing "hotspot" policing with success
- Calls for service across most of the significant crime types are down – Except for one Sexual assault file
- Community Policing Position making strides
 - East Hants Crime Prevention Groups revitalized
 - Float in Christmas Parade
 - Seniors' Police Academy
 - East Hants Citizens on Patrol revitalized and ready for duty - hotspots
 - Proactive intelligence gathering
 - Stuff-A-Cruiser Food Drive planned for Nov 27th with Food Bank and Sobeys
- Plans underway for Memorial Golf Tournament in the Spring

East Hants Operations Update

- New Shift UPDATE as of October 4th
 - 4 Watches with a dedicated supervisor (Cpl) embedded in each watch
 - Higher degree of supervision
 - Higher level of over watch for high-risk matters
 - Will enable better overlap / pass-on between watches
 - Better work-life balance for members
 - Better distribution of members throughout the week
 - Double shift on Friday night
 - Built in flexibility to transition shift coverage to meet coverage needs
- Feedback thus far has been excellent.
