East Hants Operations Update

- East Hants SCEU
 - November 2nd Project Illude
 - Joint Project involving East Hants SCEU and Integrated GIS
 - Several weeks of investigation, surveillance and intelligence gathering
 - 5 warrants executed, four arrested, multiple items seized
 - Major operation with over 30 police officers involved
 - Charges pending for theft, PSP and conspiracy
