East Hants HR Update

- East Hants District total of 29 employees (25 Police officers, 4 Detachment Assistants)
- Current staff shortage of 9 due to Illness,
 Administrative Leave, Maternity or Duty Restricted
- Shortage being offset by interim full time deployment of 5 RCMP Provincial Highway members (Overtime to fill remaining gaps)
- New Operations NCO Sgt. Martin ROY starting November 16th
- New Cst's Matt FERGUSON, Wayne TINGLEY, Mike WOOLCOCK have started
- PSE interviews for new Rawdon Assistant to take place week of Nov 23rd

East Hants Operations Update

- Assessing shift coverage in combination with mutual support with adjoining detachments (to be discussed in detail)
- Criminal Records Checks reopened to 5 days a week in Enfield from 0800 – 1200 hrs
- Rawdon Office Opened Wednesdays for full front counter service including Criminal Records Checks

- Total Time 393 hrs
 - (20 min processing time per)
 - (52 days or 10.5 working weeks)



Alternative Policing Modle

Current Model

- 10 hour shifts
- Power Shift Wed and Friday (Watch Overlap)
- On call from 0300 0700
- 168 Call-outs over past year (3 hr to 1 hr)
 - (Nov 6th Nov 6th Evenly spread each day)
 - Cost of call-outs included in package price per member
- Delay in response May be up to 30 45 min
- Adequate staff*
- * Current Shortages not sustainable, Increase required to meet anticipated demand



Alternative Policing Model Cont...

Potential Model

- 12 hour shift 0700 1900 H-Strong Proof of Concept
- 4 watches 4 members each (5 optimal)*
- 3 Supervisors (4 optimal)
- PSE support during day only (minimal support at this time)
- In isolation or in partnership with Sipekne'katik
- Power shift is flattened out over the on-call period
- Minimum Numbers in East Hants
- Adequate if in partnership
- Greater complement would help
- * PRM Study required by Planning Dept 1 year out. Historical data.
