



NEW COLLECTION CREW FOR 2023



Beginning April 1, 2023, RE Group will be taking over garbage collection services for East Hants. While the trucks and crews visiting your curbside are changing, all other services remain the same, from your garbage collection day to your bi-weekly limits.

Help us make the transition as easy as possible for everyone, by following these best practices for successful collection.

#1 TIMING

- Have all of your materials curbside by 7 a.m.
- Multiple trucks collect material from your property and they do not necessarily travel together.
- We have planned for additional fleet to service our growing communities which means earlier collection for many.

#2 ROAD ACCESS

- Some roads may experience adjusted services due to seasonal weather conditions, prior notification will be given.
- Information on road ownership (and where to direct questions on maintenance) can be found at easthants.ca/roads.

#3 RIGHT TO REFUSE

- Solid waste contractors can refuse collection for safety reasons such as rodents, insects (active hives), road conditions, and reduced access to collection points (snow/ice, parked vehicles).

#4 COLLECTION BOXES

- Use a divider to keep garbage and recycling bags separate.
- All civic numbers using the box must be marked on it (e.g., locations with end-of-lane collection).
- Loose material inside or around boxes will not be collected.
- Old appliances, such as freezers, cannot be used as collection boxes.
- Collection boxes, bins, bags, and materials setout for collection must be within 3 meters of the curb for collection.
- Make sure you group similar materials and leave space between them so they can be easily identified.
- Consider the location of your collection box from the perspective of the collection crew. Are there any trees/bushes hiding the box? Are there any decorative walls that block it from view?

Note: Collection crews are not permitted to cross the road to pick up items. For safety, material is collected on one side of a road at a time.



TAKE FULL ADVANTAGE OF YOUR CURBSIDE SERVICES IN 2023!

GARBAGE: Limit 5 bags

- No RED, YELLOW or ORANGE bags will be collected
- Black or green bags ONLY
- Max weight 25kg/55lbs per bag
- No construction & renovation waste

FURNITURE:

- Limit 3 pieces (e.g. sofa or chair)
- Max weight 100kg/220lbs per item

ORGANICS:

- 1 municipal issued cart (max. 220lbs)
- 6 paper leaf bags
- 5 bundles of brush (2ft x 2ft x 4ft bundles; max 35lbs; no branch diameter larger than 2.5 inches)

RECYCLABLES: Limit 8 bags/bundles

- Clear or transparent blue bags only
- Max weight 25kg/55lbs per bag

ELECTRONICS:

- 1 larger item (e.g. TV or computer)
- 1 small box of accessories (e.g. cords, remotes, computer mice, keyboards)

METAL:

- 1 household appliance (e.g. stove)
- 3 smaller items (bicycle, BBQ)

LIMITS & RESTRICTIONS

The table to the left outlines the collection limits (quantity) and restrictions (weights & materials) for a residential household on **every collection day**.

If you own an apartment building or business and would like more information on limits at those locations please call the Solid Waste Hotline (see number below).

Note: Garbage and recycling bags are not to exceed standard sizes (~25 inches x 33 inches).

SAME DAY COLLECTION WITH MULTIPLE TRUCKS

Curbside collection is based on week 1 = collection and week 2 = no collection. Therefore, garbage, recyclables, green cart and other acceptable items must be placed curbside on the same day. Multiple trucks mean that collection of some materials may be earlier in the day compared to other materials.

REPORTING A MISSED COLLECTION

If you believe your material was missed, or you have a collection concern, please let us know. Report your concern to the Solid Waste Hotline (same day is best!). If it is after 4 p.m. please leave a message with your name, number, civic address and concern.

BUNGEE CORDS

On collection day, please make sure that all bungee cords or green bin ties are removed as they can cause a potential safety risk to our collection crews.

NOT ACCEPTED FOR CURBSIDE COLLECTION

- Construction & demolition material (e.g., drywall, siding, flooring, insulation, decking, doors etc.)
- Unsorted waste
- Loose garbage inside collection boxes or cans

Reminder: Municipal green carts are for organics only, not regular garbage.

PROCEDURE

#1

- All vehicles must stop at the scale house.
- Declare load.
- Get directions.
- Confirm if fees are applicable.

#2

- Unload materials at designated zones as directed.

#3

- On exit, stop at scale house and weigh out.
- Pay any applicable fees.

FEES

- As part of the Municipality's Solid Waste Fee charged on residential dwellings, residents are exempt from tipping fees under the following conditions:

- The material coming in is from a property paying the annual fee.
- The resident of the property is bringing the material to the facility themselves (they can be the passenger).
- The vehicle is not a commercial vehicle.

If you have a business or are looking to borrow a commercial vehicle to bring your household's material in, please contact us ahead of time to confirm details for your exemption.

- Tipping fees are charged to all industrial, commercial and institutional locations and vehicles.
 - As noted above, if you are a resident using a work truck or borrowing a truck and bring materials in you may be charged a tipping fee. Again, call prior to arriving if this is your situation to discuss your exemption.
- Account setup is available for businesses. Contact us for more information.
- We do not accept cash at the facility - debit, credit or account only.
- Tipping exemptions (waiving of fees) is only available by approval of the CAO. For information on that process please contact us.
- The tipping fee pricing schedule is available on our website.

ORGANICS: GREEN CART Max. Weight 220lbs

All Food Waste

Including fruit and vegetable peelings, meat, fish, dairy products, cooking oil and fat (cooled, wipe with paper towel and place in cart), bones, coffee grounds & filters, tea bags, eggshells

Yard Waste/Other

- Grass, leaves, twigs, plants, sawdust, wood shavings
- Brush in maximum of 5 bundles (one bundle equals 2ft x 2ft x 4ft)
- Kitty litter

Soiled Paper

Paper towels, tissues, paper plates, napkins, sugar & flour bags, freezer & waxed paper, pizza boxes

Not for the Cart

- x No plastic bags (including those labeled 'biodegradable')
- x No ashes
- x No cans, bottles, or cups
- x No decorations or wire wreaths
- x No milk containers
- x No rocks, sod, or dirt
- x No dog feces

Note:

Excess organic material can be placed next to your green cart in up to 6 paper bags or open top containers, like a cardboard box, year round.

RECYCLABLES: BLUE BAGS Max. 8 bags/bundles per collection, transparent blue or clear bags only

Bag #1: Paper Products

- Textiles
- Catalogues, magazines, flyers
- Boxboard (e.g. cereal, tissue, and cracker boxes)
- Phonebooks
- Office & school paper
- Paper egg cartons
- Paper towel & toilet paper cores
- Corrugated cardboard (must be bundled no larger than 2ft x 3ft x 1ft)
- Newsprint
- Envelopes, file folders
- Non donate-able books (hard covers are garbage)

Bag #2: Containers

- Styrofoam™
- Aluminum cans & pie plates
- Glass bottles & jars, milk cartons, jugs & bags
- Steel & tin cans
- Juice boxes/tetra packs

Recycling Collection Notes:

- Paper must be clean and dry. Metal fasteners and plastic bindings must be removed and placed in regular garbage.
- Containers must be clean and dry, NO CAPS, NO NEEDLES
- Beverage containers (excluding milk products) can be returned to an ENVIRO-DEPOT™ for refund

Metal & Electronics Collection:

- A separate truck is used to collect metal items, therefore, collection may occur at a different time from your other recyclables. Please make sure your metal items are visible (not hidden by other bags).
- 1 large household appliance per collection (stove, fridge, etc.)
- Up to 3 other large metal items will be collected bi-weekly
Examples: microwaves, toasters, air conditioner, dehumidifier, bicycle, BBQ, cardboard box with pots, pans, utensils
- CFCs do not need to be removed from fridges for collection (the Municipality will remove CFCs)
- Items that cannot fit into the collection truck will not be collected
- Electronic Waste - Max. 1 larger electronic (TV, computer) and 1 cardboard box (1ft x 1ft x 2ft maximum) of smaller electronics (E-Readers, GPS Units, video game systems & controllers, external hard drives, optical drives & modems) per collection



GARBAGE: BLACK BAGS Max. 5 bags per collection, black or green bags only

- Aluminum foil (soiled)
- Coffee cups (disposable)
- Floor sweepings
- Frozen juice cans
- Light bulbs (wrapped)
- Broken glass, ceramic dishes (wrapped)
- Cleaner containers (non-recyclable)
- Broken toys
- Microwave popcorn bags
- Potato chip bags
- Dog feces
- Toothpaste tubes
- Vacuum cleaner bags
- Diapers & baby wipes

Note:

Garbage in RED, YELLOW or ORANGE bags will not be collected.

Up to three large pieces of furniture (i.e. mattress, sofa), or other small household items can be placed for collection on your regular garbage day.

Construction & Demolition Debris (C&D) is not collected curbside and should be taken to the Waste Management Centre in Georgefield for disposal. C&D includes siding, wood, flooring, windows, insulation, etc.

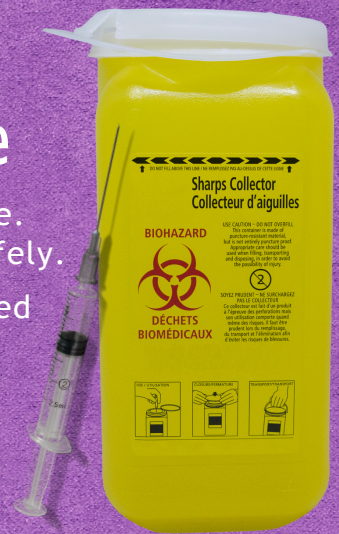
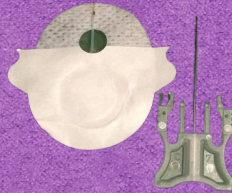
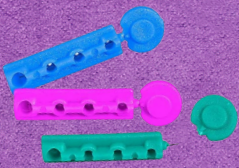
