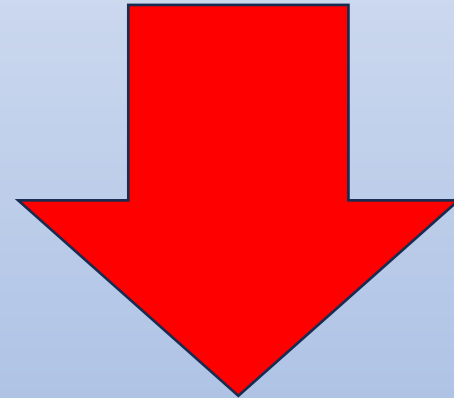

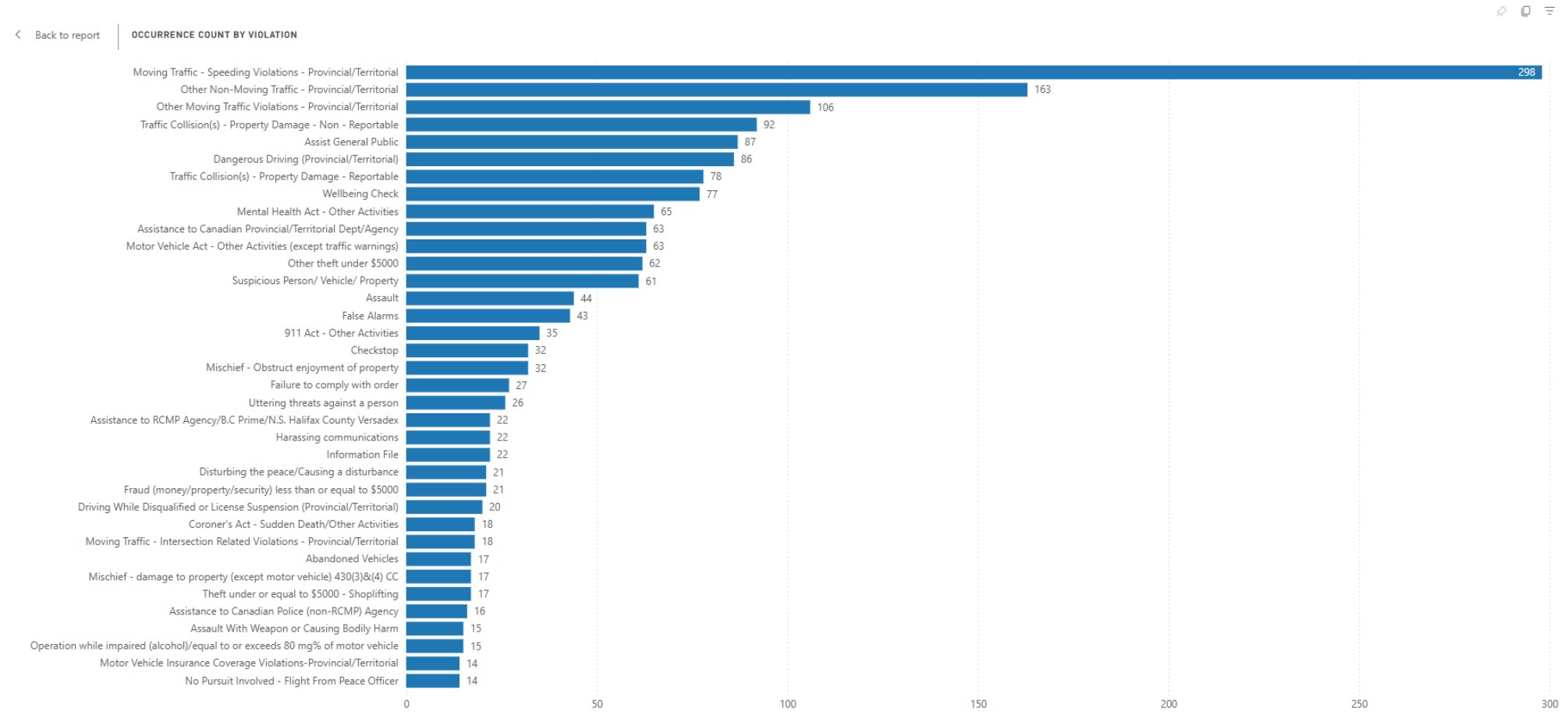

## 1. COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

### Objectives:

Leverage Municipal communications to improve RCMP delivery of services.

RCMP to attend community events.

Support the Municipality when engaging with both business and communities on crime prevention awareness.

## 2. DRUG ENFORCEMENT

### Objectives:

Increasing public awareness on completed drug operations.

Increasing public awareness on how to report drug activities through Crime Stoppers.

Work with partner agencies and schools on drug education.

## 3. ROAD SAFETY

### Objectives:

Engage with Vehicle Compliance, Municipal Digital Speed Sign (DSS) Program, and Provincial North-East Traffic Services (NETS) to target enforcement and education.
