Dear Ms. Homans,

The Municipality of East Hants is sending this letter requesting that Nova Scotia Department of Public Works change a section of yellow lines along Highway 1, Mount Uniacke from a passing section to a non-passing section.

As per Council Motion C21(350), Staff were instructed to document this official request for the Province to replace the yellow dash passing lines along Highway 1 in Mount Uniacke, between civic 125, Highway 1 and the corner of Highway 1/James Boyle Drive, with a solid yellow line. Municipal Council is concerned with reports of close calls for potential major accidents along this section of road relating to cars passing in dangerous scenarios and is looking to mitigate that risk by removing the passing option from the road markings.

Your attention on this matter would be appreciated and the Municipality of East Hants looks forward to working with your team on this item and other opportunities for improvement as they arise.
