CORPORATE & RESIDENTIAL SERVICES COMMITTEE REPORT

Councillor Perry, as Chairperson, presented the Corporate & Residential Services Committee report from their regular meeting held on October 18, 2022. The following motions came forward as a result of that meeting:

ASSET RETIREMENT OBLIGATION PSAB 3280 POLICY

Committee considered information and a draft policy per Public Sector Accounting Standard Asset Retirement Accounting Obligation (PSAB 3280). The new standard stipulates the accounting treatment for Asset Retirement Obligations so that users of the financial statements can discern information about these assets, and their end-of-life obligations.
