Responsibilities: In collaboration with the Summer Camp Supervisor, Recreation Program Leaders are responsible to lead recreation programs including supervision of participants in all activities, ensuring effective communication with caregivers and participants, daily opening and closing of facilities, managing administrative tasks such as safety checks and daily reports, and ensuring the safety and well-being of all participants. With support from the Summer Camp Supervisor, Recreation Program Leaders are responsible to provide appropriate care and adaptive inclusion supports as needed.

Qualifications:

- Preference will be given to those with experience working or volunteering with children and youth in a recreation and/or sport setting
- Enthusiastic, dependable and capable of working in a team environment without direct supervision
- Experience working with individuals requiring inclusion support an asset
- First Aid and CPR certification an asset, willingness to obtain required
- Ability and willingness to travel to the Uniacke District School
- Clean criminal records and child abuse registry checks required prior to date of hire
