Good morning all,

I hope you all stayed dry from yesterdays down pour – that sure was a lot of water!

I am emailing today as a follow-up to a question that came from our teams meeting with PPSA CAO's last month asking for the status on the Provincial Policing Standards.

As you all are aware, the standards set expectations for policies, procedures, and protocols that all police agencies in the province must meet – RCMP and Municipal Police. Once the standards are established, the new policing audit regime will serve to measure all police agencies' compliance with the standards set in place.

On March 30, 2023, the Final Report from the Mass Casualty Commission (MCC) was released. Public Safety and Security Division (PSSD) are engaged in reviewing the recommendations. When the review is completed the Department of Justice will determine how the recommendations intersect with the Provincial Policing Standards. We will update further at that time.
