

Supervisor of Solid Waste Operations -

Due to an upcoming retirement, we are recruiting for a Supervisor of Solid Waste Operations for the East Hants Waste Management Centre.

This role is available in September 2023 and will include transition time with the outgoing Supervisor.

Reporting to the Manager of Solid Waste, the Supervisor of Solid Waste Operations is responsible for the supervision and oversight of the Municipal Waste Management Centre, including operational activities, staff and contractors, compliance with policies, regulations, and legislation, customer service, and maintenance and repairs. Direct reports include Heavy Equipment Operators, the Scale House Operator, and casual staff.

Qualifications:

- Minimum three (3) years related work experience, with one (1) year of experience in a supervisory role.
- Landfill Operations, Collection & Transfer, or other applicable training through Solid Waste Association of North America (SWANA) is considered an asset.
- Experience in solid waste handling and facility operations is considered an asset.
- Post-secondary education in a related field such as business administration, environmental engineering technology, or occupational health & safety is an asset. Equivalent combination of education and experience will be considered.
- Training in the following areas is an asset: WHMIS; Transportation of Dangerous Goods; First Aid/CPR; Lock Out/Tag Out; Defensive Driving; Occupational Health & Safety Regulations; Asbestos Awareness Training.
- Ability to interpret and understand policies, procedures and legislation related to a waste management environment.
- Demonstrated experience in a customer-service oriented environment.
- Knowledge and understanding of Microsoft Office products Excel, Word, Outlook, and comfortable working with technology.
- Physically able to lift up to 50 pounds and perform strenuous activities over long periods of time.
- This position qualifies for overtime pay. Some overtime may be required in order to manage emergency situations or staff coverage.
- Valid Class 5 driver's license.
- Willing to work in and around loud noises (i.e. traffic, heavy equipment), and around odours related to garbage, organics and other waste materials managed at the facility.
