

Primary goal of CCC is to help communities:

- identify climate risks;
- assess opportunities; and,
- develop/implement climate adaptation and mitigation actions.



CLEAN'S CCC INITIATIVE

- A Climate Lead will be assigned to successful CCC recipients to enhance their adaptive capacity, community resilience and greenhouse gas emission reductions.
- Communities will have three years of support for climate change work at no cost.
- Our objectives are to action on:
 - funding applications;
 - ground implementation; and,
 - necessary policy development for climate and sustainability considerations in operational decision making.

PROGRAM STRUCTURE

Communities will be:

- Required to have an existing internal staff liaison to support the Climate Lead on the ground.
- Supported by a team of specialists at Clean to provide guidance and expertise on climate mitigation, adaptation, resilience and asset management.
- Provided with regular training and capacity building initiatives.

APPLICATION PROCESS

The Community Climate Capacity Program's application process will open in Fall 2023!

Who is eligible?

Municipal and local governments, not-for-profit organization, indigenous organizations and communities, and municipal corporations or entities, who are struggling to find the resources, support and staff to take action on climate challenges.

We encourage collaboration between community organizations, municipalities and First Nations, and we are open to joint applications!
