Low Income? Need a Ride? Apply for our Fare Assistance Program

The East Hants Community Rider has a program available for individuals that needs help accessing transportation for a reduced cost. The Fare Assistance Program reduces the price of transportation to \$5 for rides within 12 km and 50% off costs over 12 km for one day per week.

To qualify, an individual must make less than \$35,000 per year or a

couple/family must make less than \$60,000 per year.

To apply, please visit our website and <u>fill out an application form</u>. We also require a copy of an applicant's 2022 Notice of Assessment. This can be sent via e-mail, sent to our office (224 Highway 214, Suite 101, Elmsdale, NS B2S 1J7), or picked up by one of our drivers.

This program will be available until March 31, 2024 or until the fund is fully expended. Thank you to the province of Nova Scotia's Department of Public Works for this support. It enables us to help those that need it most and make our region more accessible for all residents.
