The Hants East Rural High (HERH) Boys Hockey Team was approached by the local Enfield RCMP detachment about coming together for a community hockey game with game proceeds going to a local charity. The team chose the Braeden Bannister Memorial fund because Braeden was a valued member of the HERH hockey team when he was in high school. The memorial fund is continuing to give back to our community and the boys hockey team wants to do our part to give back. All proceeds will be given to the Braeden Bannister Memorial Fund. Braeden was a grade 10 student at HERH, was a member of the HERH hockey team and a junior firefighter. In 2019, Braeden tragically passed away after a medical emergency. The Braeden Bannister Memorial Fund was set up in 2020 with two goals: to give back to the community of East Hants and ensure that every school in East Hants has a life-saving AED. The Braeden Bannister Memorial Fund has been actively fundraising and continues to support local students, athletes, and several local groups. Braeden's parents will start the game off with the puck drop on November 17. We would welcome any opportunity to profile the game and the memorial fund. We would also like to invite you to join us for the hockey game.

Under the Community Grant program, we have a \$250 event grant as detailed in the info below:

Events that encourage Recreational, Leisure or Cultural Programming, Competitions or Season Finale celebrations. Only Associations or Not-for-Profit organizations will be eligible. Grants from this category will not exceed 50% of the total event costs to a maximum of \$250.00.

In discussion with Kim, while the school eligibility does not necessarily align with a non-profit organization, given the event is in collaboration with the RCMP – it can be considered on a one-time basis.
