Good morning Kim,

As previously discussed, we are currently developing the Red Spruce Wind Energy Project on privately-held lands in the East Hants region.

As you may be aware, the next round of renewable energy procurements in the province will be officially released in December with an anticipated submittal date of April 2024. Subject to the requirements of the procurement (yet to be published), further technical and commercial analysis, and the support of the community, we will plan to bid our projects into the procurement.

While we have been communicating our intentions to develop in the area to various stakeholders in the region since 2021, we would like to officially update and notify our potential host community regarding our work and the new procurement. As such, please accept the enclosed document as our official “*Notice of Intent to Bid*”.

As you may know, we cannot yet guarantee that the project will be feasible or will meet all procurement requirements. However, we want to make sure that all stakeholders are given the possibility to provide feedback or ask questions as early as possible in the development process, irrespective of any final decision to bid the project into the procurement.

Similar to our efforts in the previous years, our team will engage the community through virtual or in-person meetings and provide updates through the respective project websites, social media, and direct conversations. More details regarding our broader engagement efforts will soon follow.

As part of our efforts to reach as many community members as possible, we kindly request that you assist us by printing the enclosed document and to add it to any poster boards or similar community notice spaces in your offices or any other public buildings that are frequented by the community members. We are also more than happy to send printed copies should that be helpful. Please also feel free to pass along to your colleagues as you see fit.
