Dear Mr. MacDougall

The 2013 Development Agreement for the Villages of Long Lake anticipates that a community association might be formed to take on a stewardship role for the trails that were to be constructed under the Agreement. The Tony Borovsky Memorial Trails Association has been established with the intention of taking on that role. The Association is registered with the Province as a non-profit society, owns a bank account, and has five directors, with a total of 12 members all residing within the Long Lake communities.

It is our plan to apply to the Municipality and to the Village Condominium Corporations (once formed) to secure a small amount of annual funding to put towards trail maintenance and operation both within Municipal Parkland and Village Common Lands. We believe that the high level of enthusiasm within our group will ensure that we can be responsible stewards for the trails for many years to come.

We now wish to enter into an agreement that would define the roles to be played by both the Municipality and our Association. We have met already with the Meek Arm Condominium Board and are working towards development of an agreement with them as well.

I trust that our request will be met favorably by the Municipality and that we can begin to work together on a formal agreement.
