**Re: Future Connector Between Highway 103 and Highway 101**

This is further to a letter from HRM Councillor Pam Lovelace to you dated February 27, 2024.

In that letter, Councillor Lovelace suggested that a connection between Highway 103 and Highway 101 be explored. The proposed connection would follow a route from the Head of St. Margarets Bay to Mount Uniacke using an existing route (Pipeline Road) as well as a new right-of-way to connect to Highway 101 at Exit 3.

East Hants Council is in support of further investigation of this possible route that would provide additional access and possible economic development.
