First Reading – Bylaw F-400-9, an amendment to Bylaw F-400, Tax Exemption Bylaw

At the February 2024 Executive Committee meeting, Staff presented a report outlining the results of the annual review of the Tax Exemption Bylaw. Two minor administrative changes were recommended including the addition of all PID's related to the Lions Memorial Park and deletion of the Shubenacadie Hall & Grounds Society as it is under new ownership and will receive provincial exemption.

Another property was added to the F-400 Bylaw exemption list for first reading at the February 2024 Council meeting. This is a property approximately 7 acres in size that was recently donated to the Uniacke & District Fire Department.

Council can now proceed with second reading.
