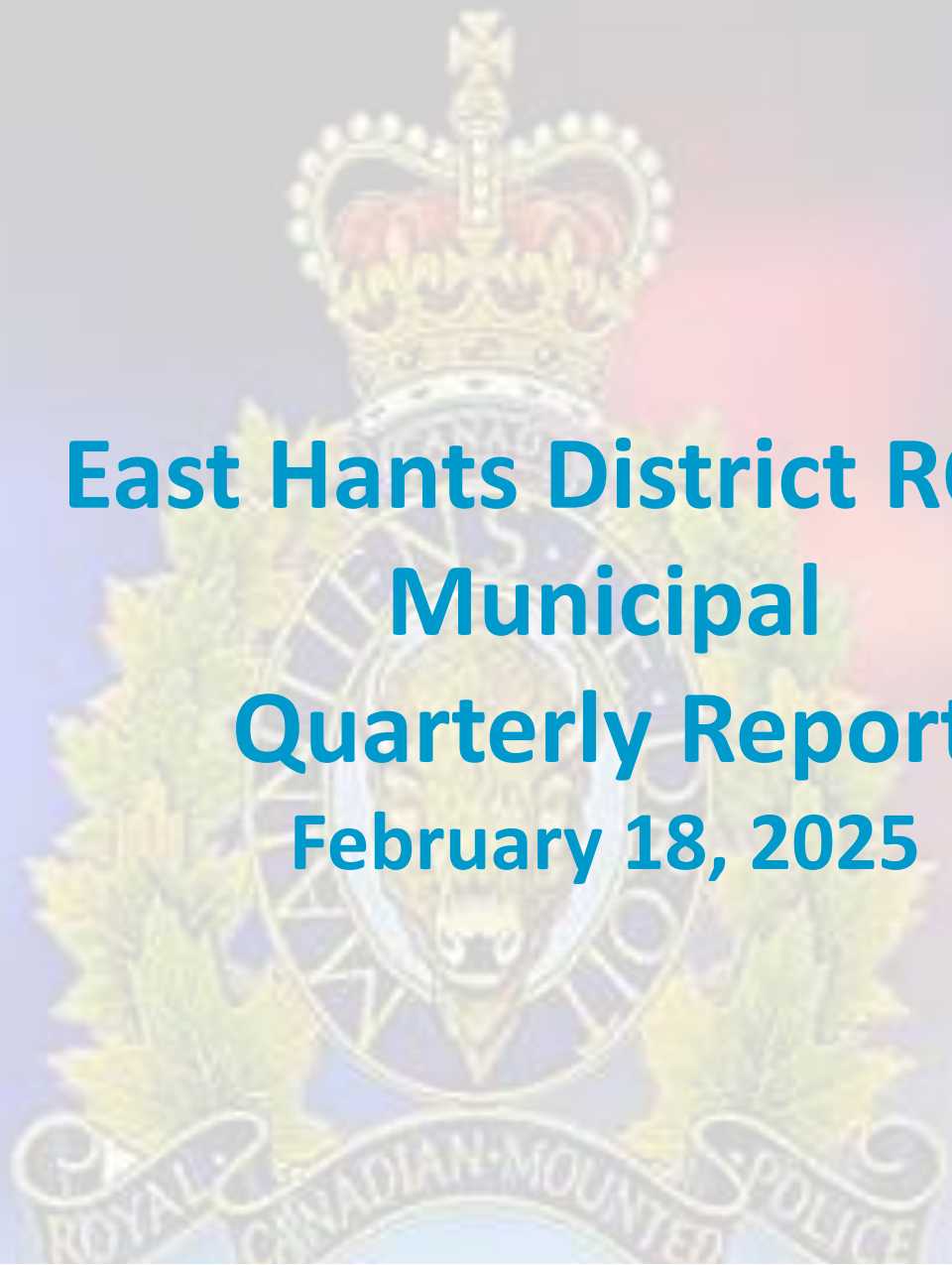

## UPDATE

- **Court Liaison Officer - Added June 2024**
  - **All Court functions in and out are now being routed through this Single Point**
  - **The addition of this position has virtually eliminated the requirement for front line police officers to spend hours assembling court files, swearing information's, handling disclosure requests etc. with the end result being more readily available.**
  - **In addition there is now an extra layer of quality assurance, consistency and efficiency added to the court flow.**

  - **All Administrative and exhibit functions are now flowing through this position including but not limited to:**
    - **Administrative tasks on operational files**

      - **Movement and continuity of exhibits for court**

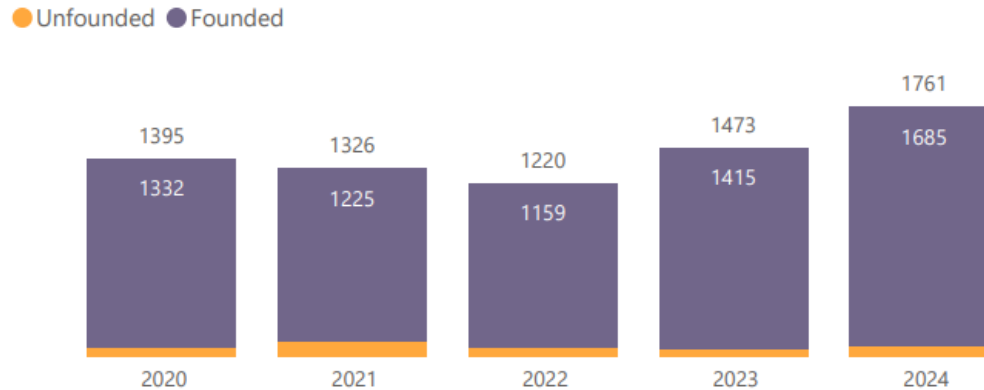

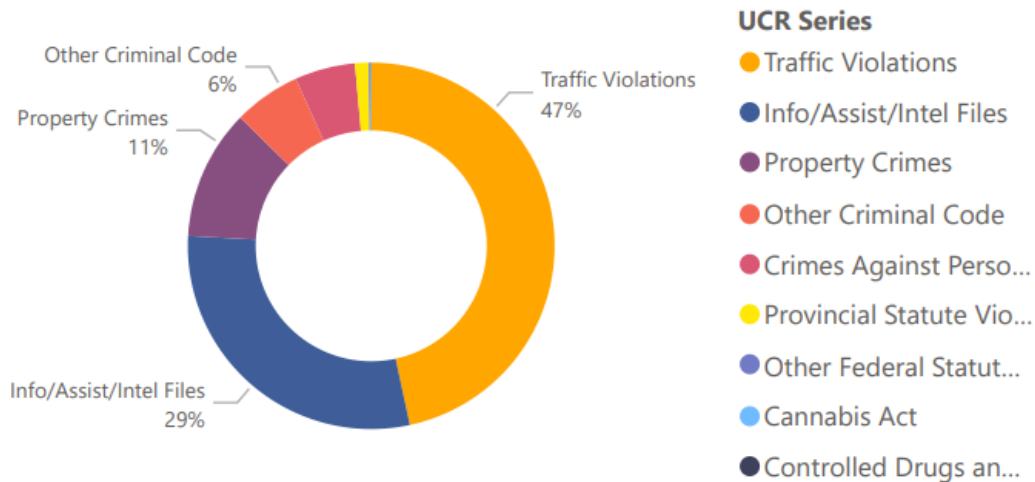

2024-2025 Q3 Reported Occurrences

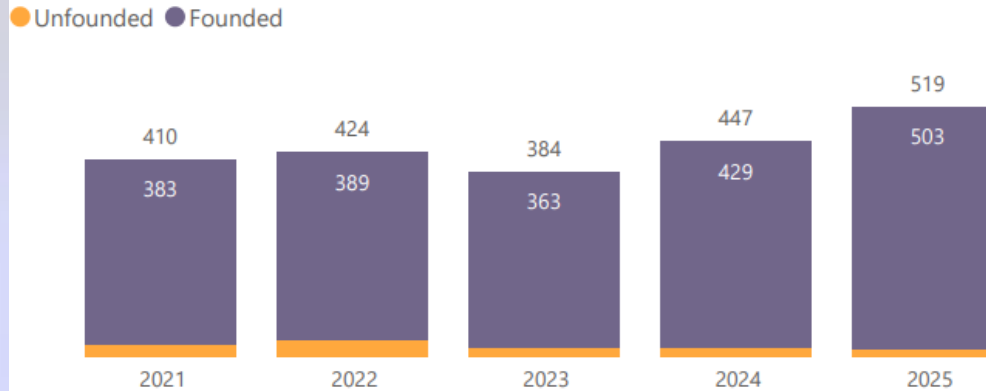


2024-2025 Q3 Reported Occurrence Composition

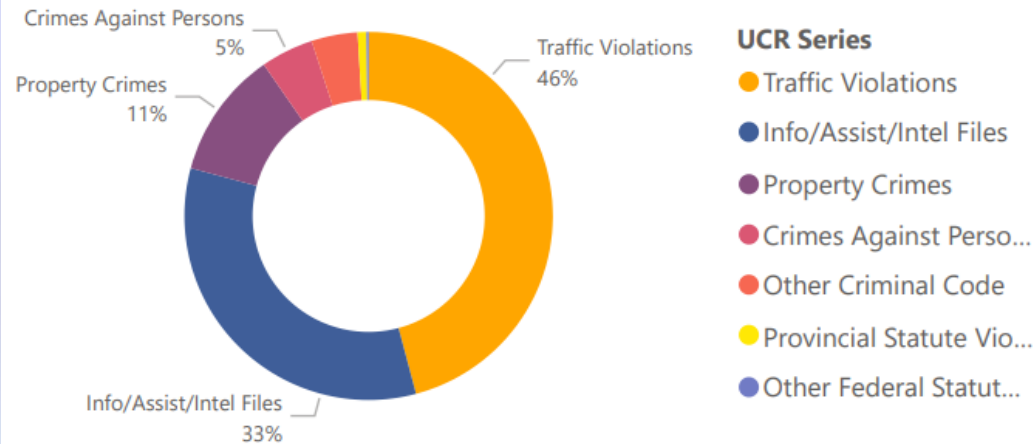

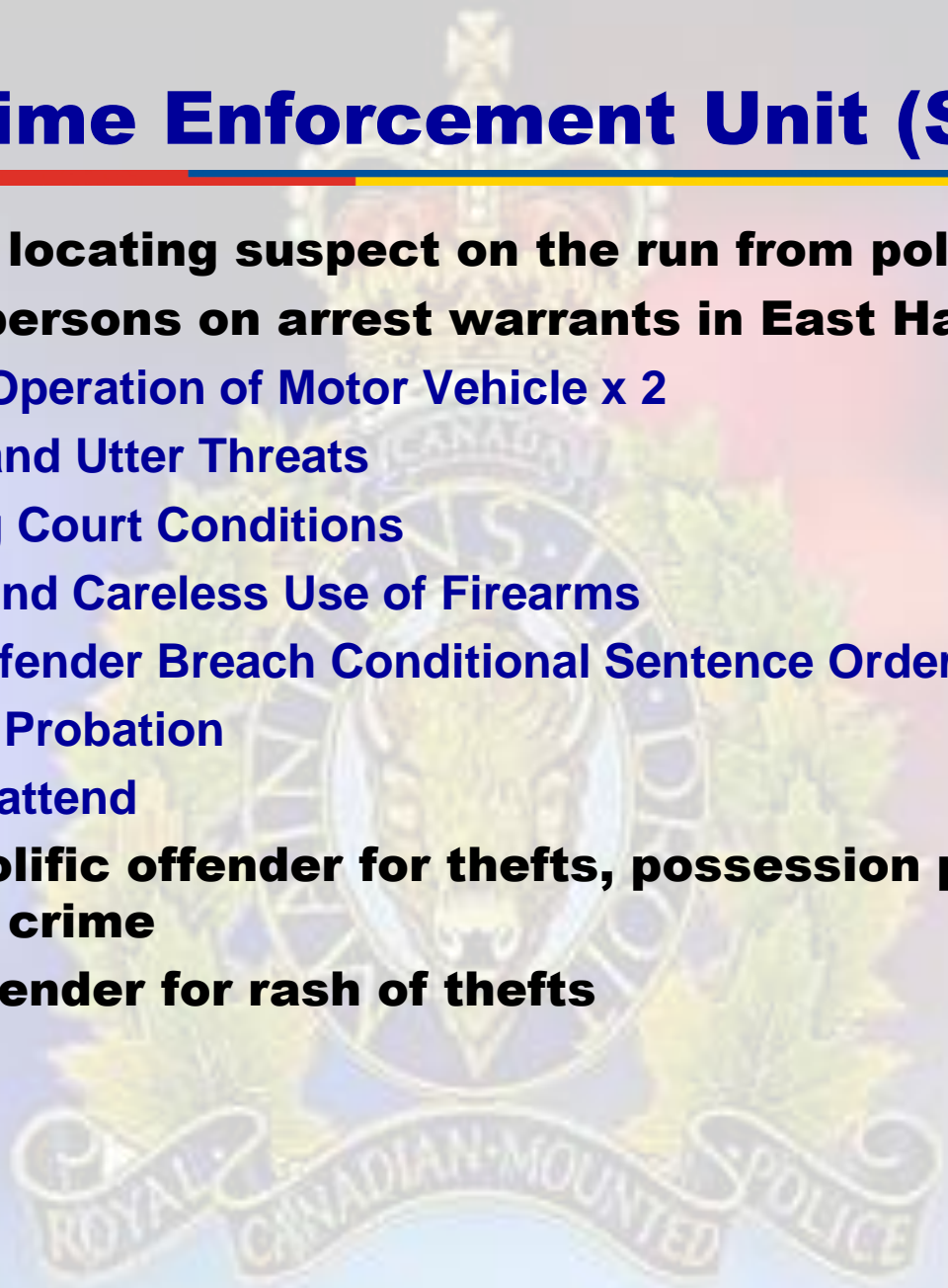
