Dear Warden Roulston:

On behalf of Minister Rushton, I am responding to your letter dated January 28, 2025, regarding Oakfield Provincial Park.

Boat wash-down stations are not part of the infrastructure provided at Nova Scotia Provincial Parks. Additionally, water systems are not maintained at all day-use parks, including Oakfield Provincial Park, where there is no operational water system. Please be assured that during the park's operating season, there is an enforcement presence at Oakfield Provincial Park.

In response to concerns regarding invasive species, educational signage has been installed. One sign, created by the Nova Scotia Invasive Species Council, and another produced by your Municipality, are both in place to raise awareness and provide guidance.
