I am a resident in East Uniacke living on Heritage Way. I am writing as a concerned resident once again as it seems that the rapidly growing community here is often overlooked by the municipality. The state of the roads 3 days after the last snow storm remains dangerous to say the least. If you drive elsewhere in the county and even in Highway 1 in Mount Uniacke the road conditions are far superior to that of East Uniacke rd. The other roads are bare and E Uniacke rd is still heavily iced and snow covered.

This is extremely concerning considering the amount of residences being built out here which tells me the situation is only going to continue to deteriorate. What will we do when there is a medical emergency, fire, requirement for police action? I drive a large off road vehicle and find myself having to drive 30km/h just to stay on the road.

Additionally, there is only 3km of road work slated for this year on the road so the state of the very narrow and heavily potholed road will only get worse.

Something should be done about this immediately. It is not prudent to continually build houses out here for tax revenue only to see the money go to Elmsdale and not returned to our community where the funding is obviously needed.
