Greetings,

On April 1, 2025, the mandates assigned to the *Nova Scotia Utility and Review Board* (NSUARB) will transition to the **Nova Scotia Energy Board** and the **Nova Scotia Regulatory and Appeals Board**. The creation of these new boards follows legislation introduced last year to modernize Nova Scotia's electricity system and enhance public utility regulation.

Each board will manage its respective responsibilities:
