Dear Minister Tilley:

The Municipality of East Hants would like to formally request that the Nova Scotia Department of Public Works reconsider their position of not maintaining K-class roads. Since the wildfires that occurred in 2023, East Hants has been in the process of identifying areas where a single access road services a larger population of homeowners. Through this process, the Municipality has identified a number of areas, where the renewed maintenance of a K-class road would allow for these vulnerable residential areas to be serviced by two access roads.

The current condition of these K-class roads would not permit a typical motor vehicle to easily navigate the roads in an emergency situation. Therefore, East Hants is requesting that Nova Scotia Public Works start maintaining certain K-class roads in situations where they could service a population in an emergency event.

Your consideration on this matter would be appreciated and the Municipality of East Hants looks forward to working with your team on this matter.
