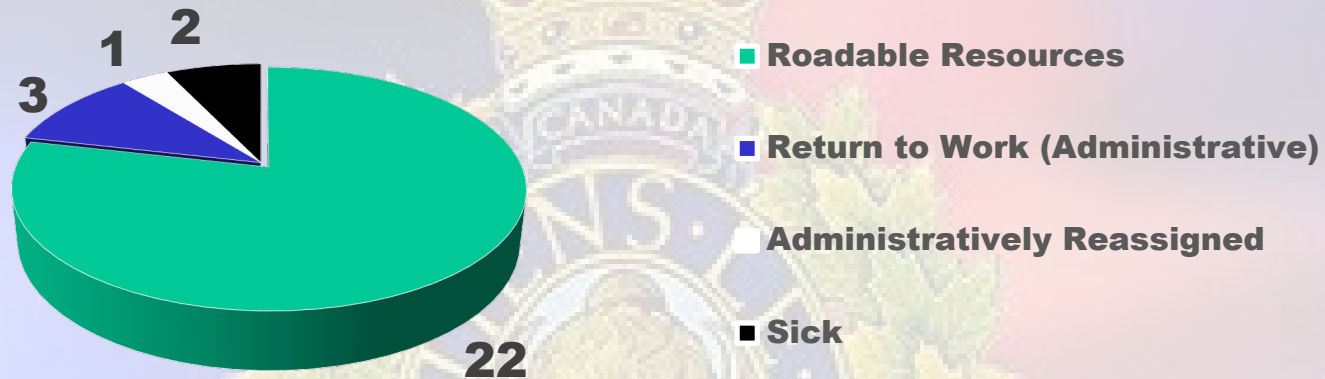

# East Hants APP Update

**April 1, 2025 through consultation with the Municipal Counsellors and the Police Advisory Committee The East Hants RCMP chose 4 policing priorities for East Hants:**

- 1. Road Safety**
- 2. Community Engagement**
- 3. Proactive Criminal/Drug Enforcement**
- 4. Improved Data to support decision making**



# East Hants APP Update

## 1. Road Safety



- Proactive enforcement  
151km/h in a 110km/h zone
- Each of these interactions also has an educational piece attached to it, in that it is an opportunity for our members to inform the drivers of not only the financial consequences but the physical harm that can be associated.

# East Hants APP Update

## 1. Road Safety

- In 2024 East Hants RCMP attended 436 Motor Vehicle Collisions, 150 of them were serious, 6 of those fatal.

## 1. Road Safety

- 3 E's of road safety - *Engineering*, **Enforcement** and **Education**
- The RCMP Criminal Operations Support Unit is committed to working with Transportation Infrastructure Renewal (TIR) to work on the Engineering portion.

## 2. Community Engagement



- On April 10, 2025 Cst. Brad Randell (watch 4) and Cpl Laurie Haines (Commercial Crime) gave a presentation on Scams targeting Seniors at the East Hants Senior Expo in Elmsdale.



- On March 25, 2025 at the Kennetcook/Noel RCMP Town Hall, Cst. Woolcock was asked the question, “how heavy is your vest?” the answer “this much”
- The Town Hall was part of the commitment of the East Hants RCMP to quarterly Formalized Community Engagements in the form of Town Hall style meetings.

### East Hants Street Crime Enforcement

- **6 Search Warrants in**

- **In these 6 searches seized:**
  - **Crack Cocaine**
  - **Cocaine**
  - **Hash**
  - **Fentanyl**
  - **Firearms**
  - **Large quantities of cash**



# East Hants APP Update

## 3. Proactive Criminal/Drug Enforcement

### Offender Management – Community Sentence Order

- **Currently 12 residents of East Hants fall within a curfew/house arrest**
- **These 12 individuals are regularly checked as per court conditions to be allowed to live in the community**

### Citizens On Patrol

- **While not part of the enforcement part of a proactive strategy, the program is being revitalized as an extension of eyes and ears in the community in real time**
- **Currently 8 volunteers at different stages of the application process**



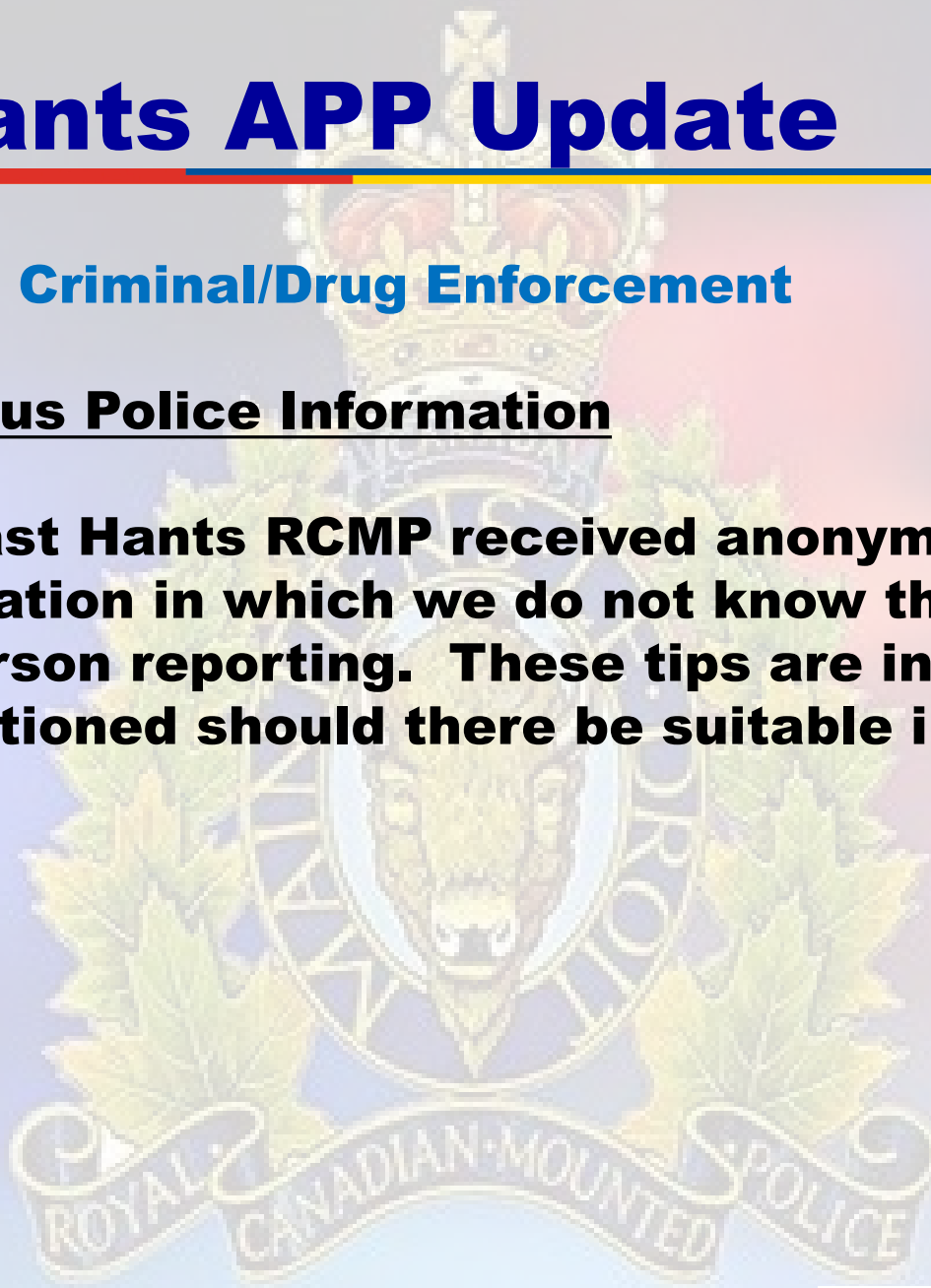
