


Community **Safety Day**

Current Grant Opportunities

East Hants Community Grant Program

Ongoing funding for recreation, sport and park/trail associations in the following categories:

- New Recreation Initiatives Grant
- Recreation Operating Grant (including maintenance)
- Recreation Programming Grant
- Event Hosting Grant

Sport Fund

Support for community sport organizations from Sport Nova Scotia.

Deadline: June 15

*Sport Fund applications are processed every two months.

Provincial Community Recreation Capital Grant

Funding to help with small scale indoor and outdoor capital recreation projects, less than \$30,000. 2025/26 funding has just opened and is ongoing.

Provincial Planning Assistance Program

Have big plans? Don't know where to start? Funding to assist community organizations in obtaining professional assistance in planning, designing and researching proposed and existing sport and recreation facilities. Program runs April to December, and is a great way to prepare for next year's capital projects.
