As per council motion C25(158), approved in April's meeting of council, the Municipality of East Hants is writing to advocate for a reduction of the posted speed limit on Etter Road, Mount Uniacke, from the current 70 km/h down to 60 km/h.

Local area councillors have been approached by members of the Uniacke Fire Service, voicing their concern with the posted speed on Etter Road as it relates to overall community safety. Apart from the limitations of historic road design, there has been a public perceived increase in road traffic in that area, leading to concern with speed and the risk of future motor vehicle accidents.

Your consideration on this matter would be appreciated and the Municipality of East Hants looks forward to working with your team on this item and other opportunities for improvement as they arise.
