Municipal Heritage Registration Application

Hearing June 25, 2025





- Application received from the Kennetcook Cemetery Society to have the church at 4295 Highway 354, Kennetcook registered as a Municipal Heritage Building.
- The building is no longer a place of worship.
- Based on the assessment of the property (appended to the staff report) staff are recommending that the building be added to the registry of Municipal Heritage Properties.



- Staff have scored the property and have assigned a total score of 64 out of a possible 130. A score of 50 is required to be considered as a heritage property.
- The date of construction is known as 1890.
- The building is in very good condition with minor modifications, although the building has vinyl siding which would not have been a traditional material.
- The location and original building design remains intact. The window openings have not been altered. The building is located on an elevated position and serves as a landmark within the community.
- The Owner (Cemetery Society) is aware of restrictions and obligations of heritage property ownership which includes deregistration requirements and issues with obtaining insurance.
