## PROVINCIAL FUNDING OPPORTUNITIES

The Department of Communities, Culture, Tourism, and Heritage (CCTH) Community Infrastructure, Active Transportation, and Accessibility grants close in 1 month! These grants compliment municipal programs in many cases.

### **Available Grant Programs (links to program guidelines and applications):**

- [Business ACCESS-Ability Program](#) Offers cost-shared grants to businesses for accessibility improvements.
- [Community ACCESS-Ability Program](#) Supports improvements to make community buildings more accessible.
- [Community Facilities Improvement Program](#) Aids in repairs and upgrades to facilities open for public use, such as community halls.
- [Connect2 Program](#) For active transportation projects that improve connectivity within and between communities.
- [Legion Capital Assistance Program](#) Assists Royal Canadian Legions with capital upgrades.
- [Recreation Facility Development / Rink Revitalization Fund](#) Supports repairs and upgrades to community recreation facilities and rinks.

**Application Deadline:** February 14, 2026
