Bylaw A-200-1, an Amendment to Bylaw A-200 Water Supply and On-Site Sewage Disposal System Upgrade Lending Program

The Corporate & Residential Services Committee received a report recommending amendments to Bylaw A-200, Water Supply and On-Site Sewage Disposal System Upgrade Lending Program to transition the program to a permanent fund capped at \$500,000 with loan repayment reinvested and minor housekeeping amendments to clarify household income requirements, adjust income limits for inflation and allow limited flexibility for applicants in default under exceptional circumstances.

The Corporate & Residential Services Committee recommends that ***Council give first reading to Bylaw A-200-1, An Amendment to Bylaw A-200 Water Supply and On-Site Sewage Disposal System Upgrade Lending Program Bylaw; and***
That the Corporate & Residential Services Committee recommend that Council extend the Well and Septic Loan Program under Bylaw A-200-1, with the program funding amount to be increased to, and capped at, \$500,000.
