We jumped at the opportunity and had the clock refurbished by our good friend of the Hall of Fame, Dale Verge. We hope to have it on display at the Sportsplex in the very near future. Our Member of Parliament, Kody Blois has been helping us with Health Canada seeking a variance from the tobacco advertising regulations so we might put it on display at the Sportsplex. Last correspondence with Health Canada leads us to believe they are now seeing our iconic score clock as a Sport Heritage item and not a 65 year old cigarette advertisement.
