As per council motion C25(309), approved in the September 2025 meeting of council, the Municipality of East Hants requests that NSDPW complete a pedestrian safety review of the roundabout at the intersection of Highway 2 and the Lantz Collector Road. Specifically, with the potential of additional safety measures, such as the Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacons that are effectively used at other locations in Nova Scotia.

East Hants requests this review in response to public concerns around the lack of pedestrian awareness of drivers using this specific roundabout in Lantz. There is a desire from the community to enable, engage and grow active transportation use in the overall area and increasing safety programming for pedestrian crossings through this intersection would be received with appreciation from East Hants residents.

Your consideration on this matter would be appreciated and the Municipality of East Hants looks forward to working with your team on this item.
