

The Municipality of East Hants is aware and supportive of the Corridor Community Options Society (CCOS) application to the Nova Scotia Community Housing Growth Fund for a planning and pre-development grant through the Community Housing Transformation Center.

This funding is essential to assessing the viability of a community housing project at 21 Convent Road in Enfield.

Since the 1970's, CCOS has provided a wide range of programs, services, and supports to people with intellectual disabilities in the communities of East Hants.

CCOS has recently completed a new, purpose built, state of the art 10mil facility in Elmsdale that is a replacement and expansion of day program services previously held at 21 Convent Road.

The Convent Road property, which is a serviced parcel of 6 acres is owned by CCOS and is available for development.

CCOS is illustrating it's commitment to provide more housing options for the communities of East Hants, and has always maintained a close working relationship with the Municipality over many years. The Municipality of East Hants highly supports the grant application as it will provide a path forward in achieving affordable, accessible housing options for our community.
