Dear Honourable Tilley,

As per council motion C26(104), approved in March's meeting of council, the Municipality of East Hants is writing to report on the re-occurring flooding conditions of the Lantz roundabout at the intersection of Highway 2 and the Lantz Collector Road.

The roundabout area has experienced water crossing the surface of the road, situated on Highway 2 between the roundabout and the East Hants Sportsplex since the completion of the Lantz Interchange project. The flows are not only challenging for pedestrians, but also create unpredictable road conditions, which was particularly highlighted during this past winter season. The Municipality of East Hants would request that a technical study be completed to analyze the location and identify flood risk mitigation options.

Your consideration on this matter would be appreciated and the Municipality of East Hants looks forward to working with your team on this item and other opportunities for improvement as they arise.
