Ordered, That a bounty of four dollars be paid for each Bear, and two dollars for each Wildcat, destroyed in East Hants, for the ensuing year.

Ordered, That the Town Clerks in each District, with the addition of A. Kirkpatrick, Esq., Shubenacadie, be the persons with whom the Surveyors of Highways shall meet to get lists of statute labor, &c., in accordance with Chapter 46, Sect. 21, Revised Statutes, 4th series.

County Regulations for East Hants for the ensuing year.

- 1st.—Any entire Horse or Bull, more than one year old, going at large at any time, the owner thereof shall be liable to a penalty not exceeding Eight Dollars for each offence.
- 2nd.—Any Ram, going at large between the first of September and the first of December, the owner thereof shall be liable to a penalty not exceeding Eight Dollars for each offence.
- 3rd.—Neat Cattle or Sheep, going at large, the owner thereof shall be liable to a penalty not exceeding Four Dollars per head for each offence.
- 4th.—Any Swine going at large, the owner thereof shall be liable to a penalty not exceeding Three Dollars for each offence.
- 5th.—Any Geese going at large, the owner thereof shall be liable to a penalty not exceeding Ten Cents for each offence.
- 6th.—Regulation 3rd, as regards Cows, Young Cattle and Sheep, shall extend only to Maitland Village, the Shore Road to Mungo's Creek, the Main Road leading towards Shubenacadie as far as the Urbania School House, a distance of one mile round Shubenacadie Station, one half-mile each round Milford, Elmsdale and Enfield Station, and one-fourth mile round Uniacke Station.
