RE: Infrastructure & Operations Committee Report

The Committee held its regular meeting on May 19, 2026 in Council Chambers. The following motions are coming forward as a result of that meeting:

1. CROSSWALK - RIVERSIDE EDUCATIONAL CENTRE, MILFORD

The Director of Infrastructure & Operations provided a history of requests for a crosswalk at the intersection of Riverside Drive and Highway 2, Milford, dating back to 2010. If a crossing guard program were to be implemented, there would be an upfront cost of approximately \$90,000 to install the crosswalk and accessibility features. Current benchmarks have the hourly wage projected to be \$18.00 to \$18.50/hour for a crossing guard. The time may vary between 10 to 20 hours per week, per crossing. If school is cancelled for any reason, the crossing guard is still paid for that day. An annual cost would be the range of \$16,000 per crossing per year.

The Infrastructure & Operations Committee recommends that *direct staff to correspond with the Province, asking for a reconsideration of a flagging program or flashing lights within school zones.*

The Infrastructure & Operations Committee recommends that *Council give notice of intent to repeal the Municipal Crossing Guards Policy and Procedures* (Crosswalk Policy).
