Second Reading - Bylaw F-300-1, an Amendment to Bylaw F-300 Respecting the Maintenance and Improvement of Private Roads

The Corporate & Residential Services Committee received a staff report at the June 16, 2026 Executive Committee meeting regarding housekeeping amendments for Bylaw F-300 to change the fee charge to road associations per Motion C24(422) reducing the fee from 5% to 3%. The reduction was included in the 25/26 budget and the bylaw amendment is the final change needed. First reading was done in June and second reading can now proceed.

The Corporate & Residential Services Committee recommends ***that Council give second reading to Bylaw F-300-1, an amendment to Bylaw F-300, a Bylaw Respecting the Maintenance and Improvement of Private Roads as attached to the Executive Committee Agenda dated June 16th, 2026.***
